## ABOUT THE COOKIE-CROOK

### 1. Definition and purpose of cookies

We use cookies and Google Analytics analytics tools to track user interests and particularly popular areas of <https://www.cityresidencebudapest.com> and use this information to improve the website and make it more user-friendly.

The process of entering, exiting and browsing the website is facilitated for visitors by small data packets, so-called cookies, which are placed on and read back from the visitors' computer devices by the website. The cookies are used to ensure the proper functioning of the website, to provide a more efficient service and to collect anonymous data of a statistical nature. Cookies may also contain personal data.

### 2. Types of cookies

- Strictly necessary cookies, which are strictly necessary for the functionality of the websites.
- Functionality cookies that make websites easier to use and improve their functionality, e.g.: language settings
- Performance cookies, which record how the user uses the website.
- Third-party cookies, such as cookies created by Facebook, Twitter and Google.

### 3. Delete cookies

Cookies can be deleted, or you can set your browser to disable cookies or delete them when you close it, but you can still use the website.

### **2. Definition of the data processed**

The start and end time of the user's visit, and in some cases, depending on the user's computer settings, the type of browser and operating system, other recorded data (cookies or cookies).

### **3. Purpose of data processing**

To identify visitors to the website, to make the services available to them, to learn about their browsing habits and to enhance the user experience.

### **4. Legal basis for processing**

Consent of the data subject - Article 6(1)(a) GDPR.

### **5. Legal consequences of non-disclosure**

In this case, the availability and usability of the website's convenience features will be significantly reduced.

### **6. Legal basis for the transfer and its legal basis**

No data will be transmitted.

### **7. Duration of processing of personal data**

The data are processed until the data subject's authorisation is withdrawn.

### **8. Information on the general rights of the data subject**

The data subject has the right to.

- to be informed by the controller whether or not his or her personal data are being processed and, if such processing is taking place, to have the right to access the personal data.
- at the controller's request, without undue delay, to correct inaccurate personal data relating to him or her.

- the controller to erase personal data relating to him or her without undue delay at his or her request and the controller to erase personal data relating to him or her without undue delay where other conditions are met
- at the controller's request, the controller restricts processing if.
  - the data subject contests the accuracy of the personal data (the restriction lasts until the controller verifies the accuracy of the personal data),
  - the data processing is unlawful and the data subject opposes the erasure of the data and requests instead the restriction of their use;
  - the controller no longer needs the personal data but the data subject requests them for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.
  - the data subject has objected to the processing; in this case, the restriction applies for the period until it is established whether the legitimate grounds of the controller override those of the data subject.
- receive personal data relating to him or her which he or she has provided to the controller in a structured and commonly used format and transfer these data to another controller without hindrance from the controller to whom he or she has provided the personal data, if the processing is based on voluntary consent or on a contract and is automated.
- where personal data are processed for direct marketing purposes, the data subject shall have the right to object at any time to the processing of personal data concerning him or her for such purposes, including profiling, where it is related to direct marketing.
- not be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which would have legal effects concerning him or her or similarly significantly affect him or her.

## **9. Information on profiling, automated decision-making**

No profiling or automated decision-making takes place.

## **10. Data storage, data security**

The controller declares that, taking into account the state of the art, it ensures the security of processing by technical, organisational and organisational measures that provide a level of protection appropriate to the risks associated with the processing.

## **11. Right to apply to the Authority**

The data subject may take the controller to court if his or her rights are infringed. The court has jurisdiction to hear the case. At the data subject's option, the action may also be brought before the courts for the place where the data subject resides or is domiciled. The court shall decide the case out of turn.
